

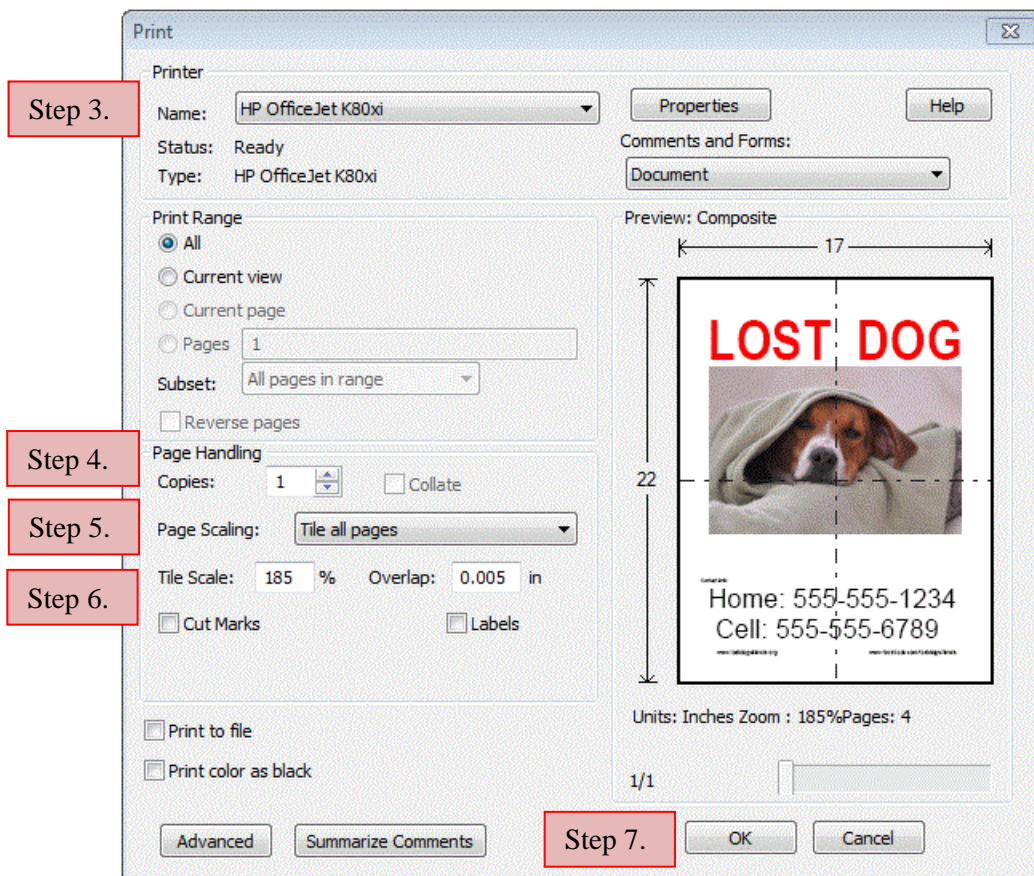
Printing a Poster



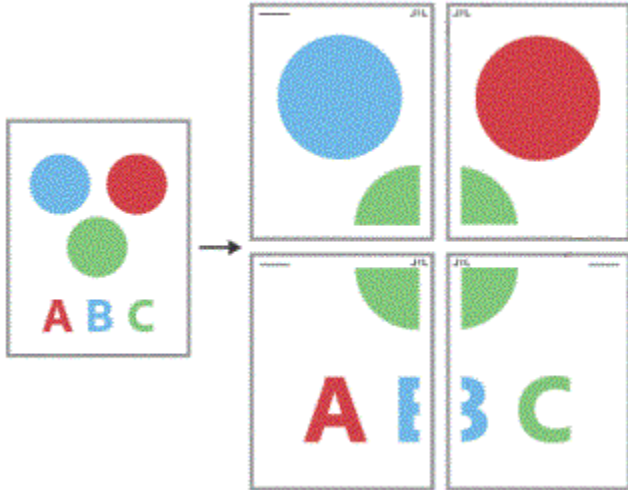
You can print a flyer across multiple sheets of paper (called "tiling"). The tiling option calculates how many sheets of paper are needed. You adhere the sheets together to create the poster. For more information, see

1. Fill out a flyer.
2. Click the Print Flyer button. The Print dialog box appears.



3. Select your printer.
4. Enter the number of copies to print.
5. From the Page Scaling menu, select the Tile all pages option.
Note: If the tile options are not in the menu, make sure that the following options are not selected in the Advanced Print Setup dialog box: Print As Image or, for Acrobat only, Separations or In-RIP Separations. Also update your version of Reader. Reader 9 does not support tiling.
6. Set the following options as needed. The page preview is on the right.
Tile Scale – Scales the pages by the amount you specify.
Overlap – Determines the amount each page overlaps adjacent pages and gives you space to adhere the pages together without covering a portion of the image.



7. Click OK.
